  - a. Tate: We've heard the feedback that the members would like to have the AGM earlier. We will definitely try to do this in January before the season kicks off.
    - i. Turner: Note that the USA Rugby NDS is January 14-15, 2016.
    - ii. Tate: Also the American Rugby Championships will be happening again this spring, dates TBD (early Feb). Hopefully one of those matches will be in Texas. We may try to match up a meeting with those events.

## 16. New Business?

- a. 7s Round Table or Camp
  - i. Tate: Based on our experience at USA Rugby Club 7s we feel that our RRRC 7s Series isn't adequately preparing our teams. I've spoken with Julie McCoy about what we can do to help improve rugby 7s in our region. We'd like to explore having a 7s focused Summit or Round Table. It would include players, coaches, referees and administrators to develop around 7s.
    - 1. Campbell: Would we consider recommending the USA Rugby 7s Coaching module? Unfortunately it only seems to be offered at Vegas 7s.
    - 2. Tate: Yes, that is available and Atavus is also offering courses. But we feel like we need to do something in our region. Our players match up athletically and physically but our skillset needs more developing across the board.
      - a. Turner: We also need to have our dates out earlier so we can work with other unions if we'd like.
      - b. Tate: We'd also like to see the return of TOLA, we want more participation and more competitive 7s.
- b. USA Rugby / TRU U21 Recruit Retain and Transition
  - i. Tate: A pilot program funded by World Rugby and USA Rugby to recruit, retain and transition players. Targeting boys that don't play after HS, they don't attend college or attend a college without a rugby program or they don't fit in with a senior club. Three regional reps have been selected:
    - 1. Houston: David Yeoman and Alex Ramirez
    - 2. Central: Bill Taute
    - 3. North: Jeff Kolberg

- a. We do anticipate having a program for girls in the future if this is successful.
- c. Donations to the TRU
  - i. Tate: With the HOF it has come to our attention that there isn't an easy way to donate to the TRU. We aren't a 501c3 and so that is difficult. We'll be talking as a Board about creating a foundation or an entity to fill this void.
